Homes Went Under Contract in April at ~50% Higher Rate Than in 2009

In the four weeks ending last Sunday, 690 single family homes in Jeffco went under contract (and have stayed under contract), com-

pared to just 460 homes staving under contract in the same four week period of 2009. This is based on my analysis of data from Metrolist. the Denver MLS. That computes to a 50% increase over last April.

In the previous four weeks, 573 Jeffco homes went and stayed under contract, compared to 425 in 2009 — a 35% increase.

Given that the unemployment rate in Colorado — a key factor in real estate activity — is basically unchanged from a year ago (8.4% vs. 8.2%), one can only conclude that this dramatic increase in buyer activity is the result of the two tax credits set to expire this Friday.
